

Three in a Row

Math Grid Game

2 Players

Object of the Game: Place three counters in a row in any direction.

Equipment Needed: Use two different types of counters, one for each player. Buttons or coins work well. 2 Dice to play.

To Play: The younger player goes first. Each player rolls the dice and uses the numbers on the dice to place their piece on the matching grid coordinate. For example: if a 2 and 3 are rolled, the player goes over three and up two or over two and up three. Either space is fine. If there is already a piece on one of the places, they have to choose the other. If both are taken already, they lose a turn. Players take turns until one of them gets three in a row.
